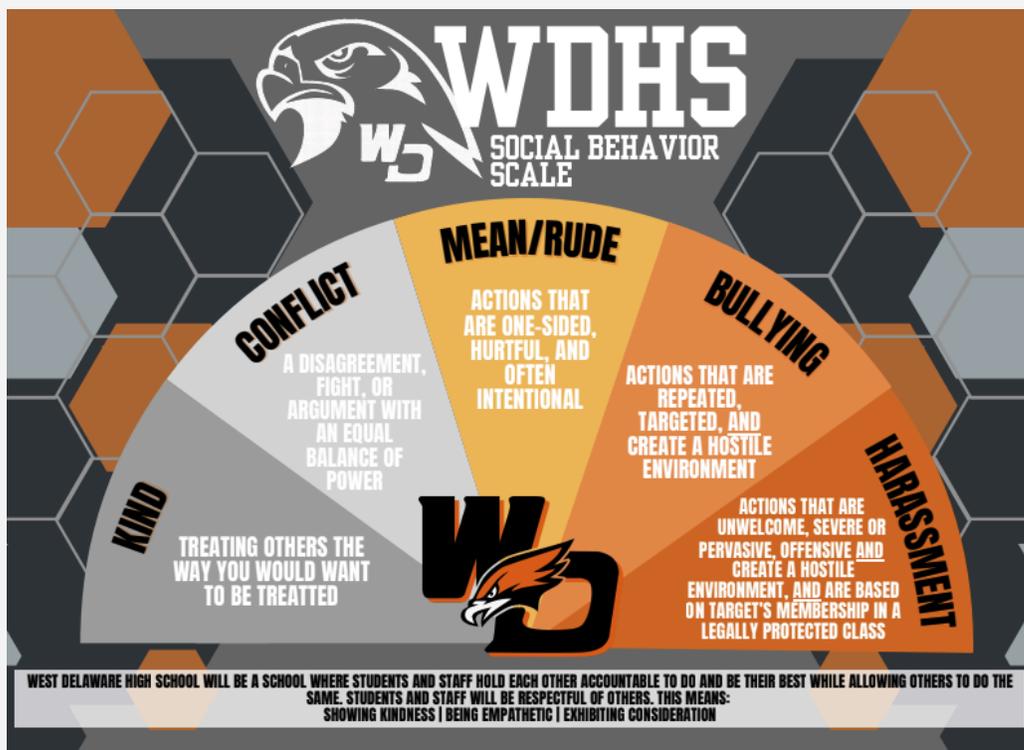

Introducing the WDHS Social Behavior Scale

To help students and families use the same language around respectful behavior, West Delaware High School is introducing a new Social Behavior Scale. The scale clarifies the difference between kindness (treating others the way you would want to be treated), conflict (a disagreement with an equal balance of power), bullying (one-sided, hurtful, often intentional actions), and harassment (repeated, targeted behavior that creates a hostile environment—including behavior tied to a legally protected class). Our goal is to hold one another accountable to do and be our best while allowing others to do the same, and to reinforce a culture of kindness, empathy, and consideration.





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WDHS Expectations for Student Behavior

At West Delaware High School, we are also committed to being a place where students and staff hold each other accountable to do and be their best, while allowing others to do the same. We ask all students to show respect in their daily choices by showing kindness, being empathetic, and exhibiting consideration. Our student behavior expectations are simple and clear: cell phones must be kept in a Chromebook case during the school day, treat everyone with respect, use appropriate language, and address staff by appropriate titles. When we all follow these expectations consistently, it creates a stronger learning environment for everyone.
